


Our offices are based at the old Bath Brewery on Toll Bridge Road. Come to the main entrance under the glass canopy and choose the bottom doorbell, which is marked 'Attika' as well as CaSA Architects. Once inside, head upstairs. We are on the first floor.



## By Bicycle

It is a short and pleasant 20 minute cycle ride from Bath Spa train station. Take the pedestrian bridge behind the station over the river. To your left you will see the canal joining the river. Simply follow the canal path for about 3 miles out of the city, passing five locks. You will have to take the bike up a few steps at one point, over a road, through two tunnels and under one bridge until you see The George public house on your left. Leave the canal at this point and follow the road heading downhill towards the river keeping the pub on your left. Cross over the toll bridge (no fee for bikes). You will see the Brewery building on the right hand side. The main entrance is at the far end of the building under a glass canopy.

## By Bus

During office hours, the number 3, First Bus (Foxhill-Bathford), runs at 15 min intervals from the main bus station, which is next Bath Spa train station. Journey time is around 30 mins. The stop you need is 'Bailbrook Lane', which is just past the mini roundabout at the top of Toll Bridge Road. Cross the main road and retrace your steps for around 20 metres. Take the steep path down to the left. This will lead you to our main entrance.

## By Car

Follow signs to 'Batheaston' from the A46 roundabout taking London Road West. You will come to a mini-roundabout, which marks the top of Toll Bridge Road. Our office is the first building on the left. Parking is on-street only and is often easier to find on London Road West rather than on Toll Bridge Road. If you are struggling to find a space, do give us a call and we will try to help you out.
